Subject: Participation in the City of San Ramon Earth Day Celebration

Recommended Action:

Review and approve participation in the City of San Ramon Earth Day Celebration.

Background:

2024 marks the 54th anniversary of the Earth Day movement. In honor of this day, The City will host an Earth Day celebration on Saturday, April 20, from 10:00am to 2:00pm, at Forest Home Farms Historic Park. The event will be in conjunction with the annual celebration of Arbor Day and a Parks Make Life Better beautification project at the Farm.

The theme of Earth Day this year is Planet versus Plastics. The event will kick off with the planting of the Arbor Day tree, at which time, participants will have the opportunity to help lay new soil around the tree. From there, attendees will have the opportunity to explore various activities and information booths. Booths will include Earth Day related crafts, information on eco-anxiety and how to combat it, a nature journaling station, native plant information booths, and historical artifacts that highlight some of the everyday dangers of products used in Victorian households. Staff will share historical information on "Dangers in the Victorian Home" that compares dangerous products used in the Victorian home to products we use in our modern homes which can be switched out for more earth-friendly products. A more thorough investigation of those Victorian items can be enjoyed during the two tours scheduled at the David Glass Historic Home Museum at 12:00pm and 1:00pm.

Staff is requesting the Teen Council assist in hosting the eco-anxiety and nature journaling booth. Hosting the eco-anxiety booth entails sharing information provided by staff on what eco-anxiety is and how people can address it. Assisting at the Nature Journaling booth involves helping participants put their journals together, sharing examples of items that can be included, and providing people with writing prompts to start their journals.
