



# NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

## ROADWAY GRINDING AND PAVING OPERATIONS

### CROW CANYON ROAD WIDENING PROJECT

#### WHAT IS BEING DONE?

Phased roadway grinding and paving operations are scheduled to take place for the Crow Canyon Road Widening Project at the following locations:

- Crow Canyon Road eastbound between Alcosta Boulevard and Barbados Drive (one lane open at all times)
- Crow Canyon Road westbound between El Capitan Drive and Alcosta Boulevard (one lane open at all times)
- Tahiti Drive south of Crow Canyon Road will be closed continuously for approximately four (4) to six (6) weeks (traffic detoured to Barbados Drive)
- El Capitan Drive southbound lanes north of Crow Canyon Road (one southbound lane open at all times)
- Intersections of:
  - Crow Canyon Road at Alcosta Boulevard (detour to Camino Ramon)
  - Crow Canyon Road at Tahiti Drive/El Capitan Drive (detour to U-turn at Canyon Crest Drive for northbound El Capitan Drive access)

#### HOW WILL YOU BE IMPACTED?

- Expect delays, watch for traffic control, and leave early for appointments
- Traffic control changes will begin on February 12<sup>th</sup> to accommodate for grinding and paving operations, including a construction speed limit of 30 MPH
- Detours will be in place as necessary, including a detour to Camino Ramon to access Alcosta Boulevard (Hospital and Post Office) when the Crow Canyon Road at Alcosta Boulevard intersection is being paved.
- Detour of eastbound Crow Canyon Road traffic to U-turn at Canyon Crest Drive, to access northbound El Capitan Drive when the Crow Canyon Road at Tahiti Drive/El Capitan Drive intersection is being paved
- Tahiti Drive will be continuously closed - traffic will be detoured to Barbados Drive
- The Tahiti Drive bus stop for Route 622 will remain temporarily closed
- Barbados Drive will remain open for all traffic

#### WHAT IS THE DURATION OF WORK?

Traffic control changes will begin on **February 12, 2024**, with paving operations to follow in late February. The anticipated duration of work is four (4) to six (6) weeks. The weather may impact this schedule.
