



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - TAHITI DRIVE CROW CANYON ROAD WIDENING PROJECT

WHAT IS BEING DONE?

Tahiti Drive between Crow Canyon Road and Bali Court will be closed continuously for approximately 4-6 weeks beginning the week of February 12, 2024. Traffic will be detoured to Barbados Drive, which has been reopened.

This closure will allow for the installation of an irrigation crossing for new landscaping as part of the Crow Canyon Road Widening Project. It will also allow for reconstruction of a portion of Tahiti Drive. The Tahiti Drive reconstruction will be completed in conjunction with a series of pavement operations on Crow Canyon Road. Those operations are weather dependent but are tentatively scheduled for mid-February through March. Additional information will be provided on the pavement work as it becomes available.

Expect delays and watch for changes to traffic control.

HOW WILL YOU BE IMPACTED?

- Tahiti Drive traffic will be detoured to Barbados Drive
- The Tahiti Drive bus stop for Route 622 will remain temporarily closed
- Barbados Drive will remain open for all traffic

WHEN WILL TAHITI DRIVE BE CLOSED AND WHAT IS THE DURATION OF WORK?

Tahiti Drive between Crow Canyon Road and Bali Court will be closed the week of February 12, 2024, and will remain closed for approximately 4 - 6 weeks.
